<u>Discussion and Possible Action on Reports from Officers and Boards</u>

Resolution 2019-15 3/8th cent county sales tax road money notification resolution:

Cavett presented Resolution 2019-15 stating that Payne County passed a county sales tax with 53% designated to be used for capital improvements on county roads, and whereas there is a need to properly maintain gravel roads and haul gravel, repair, and replace guardrail; and whereas these roads are bus routes and mail routes. Now therefore be it resolved that Payne County authorizes use of said sales tax funds for gravel, guardrail, and drainage. Cavett further stated this was an update from 2013. Motion by Cavett to approve Resolution 2019-15 as presented, second by Blasier. Roll Call Vote: Cavett-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes.

<u> Approval – Health Department Contract Renewal – Jeremy Huckaby:</u>

Reding presented a contract renewal between the Health Department and Jeremy Huckaby for security services at the health department. Motion by Cavett to approve renewal as presented and upon approval of our ADA, second by Blasier. Roll Call Vote: Cavett-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes.

<u>Approval – Contract Renewal – Frontier Fire Protection and Payne County Board of Commissioners:</u>
