

### Official Minutes of PAYNE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Payne County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular meeting of the board at 9:00 a.m. on **October 9th, 2023,** at the Payne County Administration Building, Gloria Hesser Commissioners Meeting Room 200/201, located in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

Chairman Zach Cavett called the meeting to order: Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Discussion/Possible Action on Evaluations:

Bid 2024-21 Bridge Replacement-District 3 Long Branch Creek #197- Commissioner Markum selected Railroad Yard Services, LLC as the best bid because they are overall cheaper with the steel and non-steel material and labor.

<u>Bid 2024-22 D-3 Belly Dump Trailer</u>-Commissioner Markum selected City Trailer, Inc as the lowest and best bid.
