**Transfers:** Craig presented a transfer for the Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$550,000 from Sheriff's Full Time Salaries to Sheriff's M&O in the amount of \$200,000 and to Sheriff's Capital Outlay \$350,000. Motion by Cavett to approve transfers as presented, second by Blasier. Roll Call Vote: Cavett-Yes, Manning-Yes, Harper-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes, Cowan-Yes, Craig-Yes.

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Letter of Commitment: None presented on this date.

**Range changes/discussion/possible action:** Harper with the Sheriff's Office presented a range change for D Hill and D Nack. Craig inquired with Harper if he would need additional funds to cover these range changes, Harper stated no. Motion by Craig to approve the range changes as presented, second by Cowan. Roll Call Vote: Manning-Yes, Harper-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes, Cowan-Yes, Craig-Yes, Cavett-Yes.

Approval of Employee request for Leave and/or Request for leave share: None presented on this date. Personnel Policy Updates: None presented on this line item.

**Discussion/Possible Action – Policy change/clarification RE: Full Time and Permanent Part Time Employees:** Cavett stated he had an employee that was moved to a full-time position and did not want this employee moved to full time where they are allowed benefits in regard to annual leave. Cavett inquired with Lowell Barto on clarifying the personnel policy. Cavett stated that Craig reached out to the Department of Labor and this information was forwarded onto Barto. Cavett stated that Barto revised the update Cavett had requested to be placed in the personnel policy. Cavett stated that Barto indicated in his email that he defined permanent part time as OPERS does which is someone who is required and that our policy was missing the word required. Craig had concerns and wanted to have the word required further defined with OPERS. Cavett stated that Barto's opinion is that if an employee is not being required to work 1000 hours then they can work over 1000 hours and not participate in OPERS. Craig wanted to make sure that everything is consistent across the board. Motion by Craig to table until we can reach out to OPERS for clarification, second by Cowan. Roll Call Vote: Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes, Cowan-Yes, Craig-Yes, Cavett-Yes, Manning-Yes, Harper-Yes.

<u>New hires/discussion/possible action</u>: Harper stated he had five (5) new hires, not new positions just filling positions.
