

Official Minutes of PAYNE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Payne County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular meeting of the board at 9:00 a.m. on **Monday, March 23rd, 2020** at the Payne County Administration Building, Gloria Hesser Commissioners Meeting Room 200/201, located in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

Chairman Chris Reding called the meeting to order:

Meeting called to order at 9:30 a.m.

The following members were present:

Chris Reding – District 2 Commissioner, Zach Cavett - Commissioner District 1, Rocky Blasier – Commissioner District 3, Tammy Mathis – Deputy County Clerk. Invocation by Zach Cavett and Flag Salute to our country by Chris Reding.

Approve minutes of the previous meeting of the board:

The Clerk's office presented minutes from the previous meeting. Motion to approve the minutes of March 16th, 2020 meeting with one minor change by Cavett, second by Blasier. Roll Call Vote: Cavett-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes.

Miscellaneous items from the Audience (no action will be taken):

Roger Gose with Gose & Associates presented before the board working on a project off of 19th and Jardot with District 3. Gose would like to work on a sewer line and inquired what paperwork would need to be done to complete with the county. It would serve over one hundred (100) residents. Gose wanted to know if the Commissioners would consider closing the right of way some time in the future but knows there have been concerns in the past. Gose is representing the developer today so trying to help keep his project moving. Cavett was against vacating that roadway, but fine with the sewer line referencing this was Blasier's District but did have concerns of vacating that roadway. Barto stated you can run a permit through like a road crossing. No action.

We are activating our EOC today in response to this new confirmed case. We will be coordinating with all of the different agencies so we can get a grasp on where we are at as a county. Motion by Cavett to extend the proclamation for thirty (30) more days, second by Blasier. Roll Call Vote: Cavett-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes.

Resolution 2020-06 – Weight Limit Postings for Coyle Road from SH33 to SH51: Blasier presented Resolution 2020-06. After discussion, motion by Blasier to approve Resolution 2020-06 as presented, second by Cavett. Reding inquired on the road just recently being redone. Blasier stated it will be rated at the weakest end to overall cover this entire road which had somewhat recently been done. Class 5 vehicles will be 8 tons, class 6 will be 10 tons, class 7 will be 14 tons, and class 9 will be 16 tons. Roll Call Vote: Cavett-Yes, Blasier-Yes, Reding-Yes.

Approval contract with High five media and the Clerk's Office: The Clerk's Office presented an agreement with High Five Media for the County Clerk's Office new website. Reding inquired on the price. Mathis provided the purchase order with the pricing and information for the site. Barto, ADA said he had reviewed the agreement and it was fine to proceed.
