Cavett stated he did show the Mpower building to Stillwater Group Homes and they would be looking into the possibility in leasing the entire building.

<u>New Business</u>: Ridgeline (portable mixing plant) wants to make use of the old Mpower building just across the fence with loading the dust on one side and the load and fill tank would be on District 3's side. They are wanting to run the water hydrant hose across the driveway over to their plant. They would be on both sides of the fence. Blasier wanted to know if anyone saw a problem with allowing them to do that. Cavett stated the last time he used them at District 1 he said they did a great job at leaving the site the same way they found it or better. Cavett stated he had no problems with it especially since the old Mpower building is empty. Blasier stated Rich Wine of Cement Solutions would come in after the Fair and probably be there about a month.
