

The Payne County Board of County Commissioners met in a regular meeting of the board at 9:00 a.m. on **September 28, 2023,** at the Payne County Administration Building, Gloria Hesser Commissioners Meeting Room 200/201, located in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

<u>Chairman Zach Cavett called the meeting to order:</u> Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m.
