CEMENT SLURRY:

The following specifications are for the minimum requirements for Cement Slurry delivered to a designated area in Payne County.

The awarded vendor must supply all, Statements, and Insurance as required by law, which includes but is not limited to Owner's Protective Liability Insurance naming Payne County as the insured, to protect the County against claims arising out of operations of Contractors and other independent Contractors, as well as omissions of supervisory acts of the County in connection with the performance of the contract covered by these specifications in the following minimal amounts.

BODILY INJURY LIABILITY in an amount no less than \$100,000.00 for injuries including accidental death, to any one person, and subject to the same limit for each person, in an amount not less than \$300,000.00 for one accident.

PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY Limits shall be carried in the amounts of not less than \$50,000.00 for any one incident.

Unit Prices will be guaranteed correct by the bidder.

This bid is submitted as a legal offer and any bid when accepted by the County binds the bidder. Bidder must comply with all bid regulations listed in this bid packet. Proof of compliance to the bid specifications shall be the responsibility of the bidder. All goods and services shall be furnished by the time indicated on the Bid Pricing Sheet.

DESCRIPTION

The cement slurry shall be delivered and applied into subgrade soil by the vendor at specified rate determined by the District Commissioner. Prior to delivery and application, the vendor may be required to provide material samples for lab testing and mixing with native subgrade soil from the project site. The County will determine the design percentage of materials and will inform the vendor what the desired application rate of the cement is needed for the roadway subgrade to be stabilized. This application rate will be based on lab testing of the subgrade soils to achive the required compressive strength.

MATERIALS

Cement shall conform to the requirements of ASTM C150/150M. To prevent lumps and any foreign material from damaging the slurry mix, the cement powder should be stored in a weatherproof storage unit.

Slurry mix should contain a minimum of 55% cement material by mass.

Slurry mix should contain a stabilizing agent for maintaining a homogenous mixture of cement material, in water, for a minimum of 4 hours after it has been batched.

MATERIAL TESTING

500 ml portion of the slurry will be removed from the middle of the load. The slurry suspension will be monitored with no vibration or agitation at ambient temperature for 30 minutes. Little of no separation of liquid or solid should occur. The Marsh Funnel viscosity of the slurry, according to ASTM D6910, should be a minimum of 60 seconds when it is measured.

EQUIPMENT

The slurry plant should be a hydraulic/pneumatic mixing plant with the capability to monitor and regulate flow rates and line pressure, Slurry proportion shall be regulated by calibrated scales. The slurry solution shall be mixed using a high energy static mixing apparatus. All mechanical mixing must be pump driven. Lime slaking tanks, paddle driven mixers and other similar technology shall not be employed.

The Slurry plant should provide safe and easy access for the Engineer to obtain samples.

The cement slurry should be delivered to the project site in a non-baffle tank vehicle that does not recirculate or agitate the slurry materials by any means other than the motion of the vehicle in normal movement.

Application of the cement slurry shall be uniformly injected below the subgrade surface and into substrate soil. The vehicle that injects the slurry into the subgrade soil shall meter the specified design amount of slurry per square yard and adjust flow rate based on the speed of the vehicle. Tickets shall be generated through the function of calibrated plant scales for the amount (per ton) of dry cementitious product deliver to the project site

MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Cement slurry for soil stabilization shall be measured and billed by the dry ton of cement delivered and applied to the subgrade soil. It shall also include samples of material needed for laboratory soil testing.


