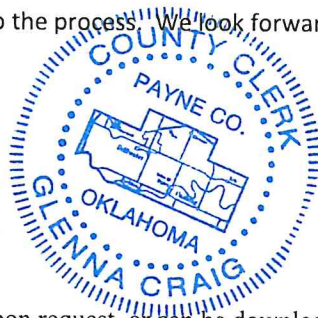

THESE ITEMS APPLY TO AND BECOME A PART OF THE BID
NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED

1. Bids must be submitted on the included form only. Each bid shall be placed in a separate envelope. Be sure the envelope is completely and properly identified and sealed, showing the bid name and number in the lower left-hand corner.
2. All bids shall be entered on the Bid Form enclosed or a copy thereof. Bids are to be typewritten or in ink. No bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of thirty (30) days after the date and hour set for the opening of bids.
3. The bidder shall attach the manufacturer's name of the equipment or material to be furnished, type model numbers descriptive bulletins and specifications. All guarantees and warranties should be clearly stated. This data shall be sufficient detail to describe accurately the equipment or material to be furnished. Manufacturer's specifications, in respect to the successful bidder, shall be considered as part of the contract with Payne County.
4. Any exceptions or deviations from written specifications shall be identified in writing and attached to the bid form.

All BIDS must be made on the required BID form. All blank spaces for BID prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and the BID form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Only one Copy of the BID form is required.

The OWNER may waive any informalities or minor defects or reject any and all BIDS. Any BID may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of BIDS or authorized postponement thereof. **Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours before time specified and Bids received after the time set for opening Bids will not be considered and will be returned unopened.** No BIDDER may withdraw a BID within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Should there be reasons why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period; the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the OWNER and the BIDDER.

BIDDERS must satisfy themselves of the accuracy of the estimated quantities in the BID schedule by examination of the site and a review of the drawings and specifications including ADDENDA. After BIDS have been submitted, the BIDDER shall not assert that there was a misunderstanding concerning the quantities of WORK or of the nature of the WORK to be done.

The OWNER shall provide to BIDDERS prior to BIDDING, all information which is pertinent to, and delineates and describes, the land owned and rights-of-way acquired or to be acquired.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond payable to the OWNER for five percent of the total amount of the bid. A certified check may be used in lieu of the bid bond. No bid security is required if bid is \$7,500.00 or less. As soon as the bid prices have been compared, the OWNER will return the bonds of all except the three lowest and best responsible bidders. The bid bond of the successful bidder will be retained until the Performance Bond, Statutory Bond and Certificate of Insurance have been executed and approved, after which it will be returned. The bid security of the two remaining unsuccessful Bidders will be returned after the successful Bidder has entered into a contract and has furnished the required bonds and insurance.

A Performance Bond, Statutory Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract Price with a corporate surety approved by the OWNER will be required for the faithful performance of the Contract.

The party to whom the contract is awarded will be required to execute the Agreement and obtain the Performance Bond, Statutory Bond and Certificate of Insurance within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date when Notice of Award is delivered to the Bidder. The Notice of Award shall be accompanied by the necessary Agreement and Bond forms. In the failure of the Bidder to execute the Agreement, the OWNER may consider the Bidder in default in which case the Bid Bond accompanying the proposal shall become the property of the OWNER.

Payne County Commissioner District 3 is requesting sealed bids for Replacement of Bridge CN#126, located over Unnamed Creek, 4.00 miles North and .75 miles West of the Town of Coyle (5.70 miles East of I-35 on E0690 Rd. or W. 92nd Ave.) in Payne County District #3.

Contractor will furnish all necessary equipment and labor, along with all warning signs and liability insurance for safety; and prevent any liability against Payne County while work is in progress. All work will be subject to inspections by Payne County and work performance bond. Work can begin when all bonds are on file in the County Clerk's Office and County Commissioner is ready.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC: All work shall be performed in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). The successful bidder shall furnish and place all warning devices and other traffic control devices required to direct, control and protect the traveling public during the complete process of the bridge construction.

INDEMNIFICATION: The Contractor hereby agrees to assume all risks and responsibilities inherent in performing the contracted services and does hereby agree to defend, hold harmless, indemnify, release and forever discharge Payne County and any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and servants from and against any all claims, demands, and actions, causes of action, losses liabilities, or expenditures of any kind, including court cost and expenses, accruing or resulting from any suits or damage of any character resulting from injuries, damages, or death sustained by any person or persons, or property, by virtue of the performance of this agreement either directly or indirectly.
