TERMS AND CONDITIONS
THESE ITEMS APPLY TO AND BECOME A PART OF THE BID
NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED

1. Bids must be submitted on the included form only. Each bid shall be placed in a separate envelope. Be sure the envelope is completely and properly identified and sealed, showing the bid name and number in the lower left-hand corner.
2. All bids shall be entered on the Bid Form enclosed or a copy thereof. Bids are to be typewritten or in ink. No bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of thirty (30) days after the date and hour set for the opening of bids.
3. The bidder shall attach the manufacturer's name of the equipment or material to be furnished, type model numbers descriptive bulletins and specifications. All guarantees and warranties should be clearly stated. This data shall be sufficient detail to describe accurately the equipment or material to be furnished. Manufacturer's specifications, in respect to the successful bidder, shall be considered as part of the contract with Payne County.
4. Any exceptions or deviations from written specifications shall be identified in writing and attached to the bid form.
5. The enclosed affidavit for Filing with Competitive Bid **MUST** be returned with the bid.
6. Payne County reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any technicalities in the bidding.
7. Direct purchase of certain items of equipment or material by Payne County is exempt from Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma Sales Tax. In such cases, the bidder shall quote prices which do not include Federal Excise Tax and Oklahoma Sales Tax.
8. Bid must show number of days required for delivery under normal conditions. Contractor must keep the County advised at all times of the status of the order. For any exception to the delivery date as specified on this order, vendor shall give prior notification and obtain written approval from the Purchasing Agent. Default in promised delivery date or failure to meet specifications, authorizes the County to purchase supplies elsewhere and charge the full increase of cost and handling to defaulting contractor.
9. Bidder agrees to defend and save Payne County from and against all demands, claims costs expense, damage and judgments based upon infringement of any patent to goods specified in this order or the ordinary use or operation of such goods by the County or use or operation of such goods in accordance with the bidder's direction.
10. If the bid requires a written contract, the successful bidders shall execute a written contract with the county within (10) days after submission of the contracts to said bidder.
11. This bid is submitted as a legal offer, and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.
12. **If the bid is \$50,000.00 or greater, Bidder must furnish a bid bond or cashier's check in the amount of 5% of the bid with bid submission.**
13. **If the bid is \$50,000.00 or greater, successful Bidder must be able to bond. (Performance, Maintenance and Payment Bonds)**
14. Successful bidder will be required to furnish their own Workmen's Comp and General Liability Insurance as required by Oklahoma State Law and by Payne County.

1. Fill out "Invitation To Bid" form completely.
2. Sign "Invitation To Bid" form (Terms and Conditions) and have signature notarized.
3. Identify outside sealed envelope as follows:

4. File Bid Proposal with the Payne County Clerk, either by mail or in person to 315 W. 6th Ave. Suite 202, Stillwater, Oklahoma, 74074, on or before 9:30 A.M. on October 17, 2022. Bids received after this time will be rejected and returned unopened.

6. All forms must be filled out completely. Any incomplete forms could result in rejection of bid, if the Board of County Commissioners considers such action to be in the best interest of Payne County.
7. 61 OS 107 - Bid Bond: Each bidder on a public construction contract shall accompany his bid by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond equal to 5% of the bid. Said certified or cashier's check or bid bond shall be returned to the successful bidder on execution and delivery of the contract and required bonds and insurance. Checks of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned to them in accordance with the terms of the proposal.
8. 61 OS 113 - Execution of contract: Contract shall be executed within 60 days. Within said period of time the following shall be provided by the contract to the awarding public agency:
 - a. Statutory Bond: Sum not less than the total amount of the contract, conditioned that such contractor shall pay all indebtedness incurred by such contractors or subcontractor who perform work in the performance of such contract, for labor and materials and repairs to and parts for equipment used.

- b. Performance Bond: Sum equal to the contract price with adequate surety to insure the proper and prompt completion of work in accordance with the provision of the contract and bidding documents;
 - c. Maintenance bond: Sum equal to the contract price to protect the agency against defective workmanship and materials for a period of one year after acceptance or longer as stated in the specifications.
 - d. Public liability and workers compensation insurance during construction in reasonable amounts.
9. All bid information shall be typewritten or legibly written in ink. All corrections shall be initialed by the person signing the Invitation to Bid form.

BID SPECIFICATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION
FOR ASPHALT OVERLAY

SPECIFICATIONS:

1. All materials and labor shall be in accordance with the Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, Oklahoma State Highway Commission, 2009 Edition, and any subsequent revision.
2. This project is for asphalt overlay of:
 - A. Stiles Road from HWY 33 south to 9th- 1 mile- 3in A 1 ½ in B
 - B. Deep Rock Road from HWY 18 east to Linwood- 1 mile- 2 ½in A 1 ½ in B
 - C. Linwood from Deep Rock Road north to Fairlawn- 1 mile- 2 ½ in B
 - D. Union from Lakeview south to McElroy- 1 mile- 3in A 2 ½ in B
 - E. Union from McElroy south to HWY 51- 1 mile 2 ½ in B
 - F. Union from HWY 51 south to 19th- 1 mile- 2 ½ in B
 - G. Union from 19th south to 32nd- 1 mile- 3in A 2 ½ in B
 - H. Sage from Prairie west to Equine Dr- .41 mile- 1 ½ in B

Payne County District 1 reserves the right to withdraw or adjust any portion of the asphalt overlay projections or thicknesses.

3. Project will be a minimum of 22 feet wide or to match existing roadway.
 - A. Thicknesses noted above are compacted thicknesses.
4. All bridge tie-ins are to be milled to a depth of 2 inches. Add alternate Bid
5. Contractor will be responsible for all intersection tie-in's and/or transitions.
6. A 4-foot apron will be required at predetermined points and driveways designated by the County Commissioner.
7. Road preparation is to be completed by the County. The Contractor will be responsible to supply any and all water required for the Contractors' needs. The road will be watered at the discretion of the County Commissioner.
8. Bid will be for cost of asphalt per ton laid in place including tack oil.
9. County will collect bill of lading tickets from every truckload. Said ticket tonnage will be used as basis for calculation of total tonnage used for the project.

10. Contractor will be responsible for the patching of any and all holes that develop during the overlay process.
11. Contractor will be responsible for all traffic control according to MUTCD.

NOTE-No bridges will be overlaid unless written consent is provided by
County Commissioner

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Before bid is awarded vendors may be contacted by commissioner to determine time frame in which project can be worked and completed.
2. A pre-work conference with the successful bidder and commissioner prior to the start of the project will be required.
3. All work shall be completed 60 calendar days from notice to proceed date. Contractor and Owner recognize that time is of the essence of this Contract and that Owner will suffer financial loss if the work is not completed within the times specified above, plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with the standard specifications. The parties also recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving, in a legal or arbitration proceeding, the actual loss suffered by Owner if the work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Owner and Contractor agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as penalty) , Contractor shall pay Owner \$2,000.00 for each day that expires after the time specified for completion.
